The Elk County Commissioners met on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 10:00am in Conference Room No. 2 of the Courthouse Annex. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those physically present were Commissioners Joseph Dagher, M. Fritz Lecker and Matthew Quesenberry. Also present were Tom Wagner, County Solicitor; Seth Higgins, Chief Clerk; Samantha Mitchell, Deputy Chief Clerk; Dan Rimer, I.T. and Brian Stockman, Press. Members of the public present via zoom were Amy Kessler, Mr. Alexander, Kirk Zimmerman and Beverly Lenze.

Matthew Quesenberry made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by M. Fritz Lecker and carried unanimously.

M. Fritz Lecker made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 6, 2021 meeting seconded by Joseph Dagher and carried unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Bid opening for 2004 Ford F350 has been tabled until the next Commissioners' meeting that will be held on May 4, 2021 due to not receiving any bids on the vehicle. The County will still be accepting bids on the truck.
2. M. Fritz Lecker made a motion to approve the Elk County Fair grant application for Room Tax funds for \$3,500.00 based on the recommendation from the Elk County Room Tax Committee. This motion was seconded by Matthew Quesenberry and carried unanimously.
3. M. Fritz Lecker made a motion to approve the Fox Township application for Liquid Fuel funds for \$7,000.00 for paving township roads (T-546 Linwood Ave), (T-547 Pinecrest Road) and (T-548 Cedar Ave). This motion was seconded by Matthew Quesenberry and carried unanimously.
