

Facility Dog

The Elk County Prothonotary/Clerk of Court (handler) provides an on-site facility dog. A facility dog is an expertly trained dog who partners with a facilitator working in a Court setting. Canine Companions for Independence's (CCI) facility dogs are trustworthy in professional environments and can perform over 40 commands designated to motivate and inspire clients with special needs, and offer a sense of control to those who have experienced abuse/trauma, or who have witnessed violence.

Praline is a facility dog that was selected by Canine Companions for Independence (CCI) to work with children/court users who visit our Court, or to accompany the handler out in the work field. When available, Praline can visit with your child and you during your visit to our Court.
