Under the provisions of the Act of April 27, 1925, PL 324, the Commonwealth pays this allotment to the County of Elk to be disbursed to townships and schools where the Allegheny National Forest is situated. These funds are to be used for schools and roads.

The County must divide the allotment, 75% for schools, 25% for roads, unless the citizens of the township have voted for a 50-50 split. In Elk County, the citizens of all townships have voted for a 50-50 split of the National Forest Allotments between the schools and roads. The amount of the distribution is determined by the acreage of National Forest land in each township.

### 2015 County of Elk Contingent Liability Elk County Industrial Development Authority Guaranteed Revenue Refunding Bonds ----Series of 2010

On September 29, 1994 the Elk County Industrial Development Authority and Elk Haven Nursing Home Association incurred a \$4,765,000, Series of 1994, Bond Issue obligation. In 1994, \$1,765,000 of the bond money was used to pay off the existing 1977 Elk Haven Nursing Home Association Bonds. The remaining \$3,000,000 was used for construction of a new 40-unit personal care facility, Silver Creek Terrace, and for renovations to the original Elk Haven Nursing Home.

The County had a contingent liability against its full faith and credit on the \$4,765,000, Series of 1994, Bond Issue of the Elk County Industrial Development Authority. On December 1, 1997, in order to reduce interest costs, the Elk County Industrial Development Authority refinanced the remaining balance of its original obligation, \$4,470,000, with the \$4,495,000, Series of 1997, Bond Issue. On December 15, 2002, the Elk County Industrial Authority and the Elk Haven Nursing Home Association again refinanced the remaining balance of \$3,785,000, with the \$4,315,000, Series of 2002 Bond Issue. This transpired with the intention to both reduce interest costs and incur additional funds to provide for the purchase and installation of a power generator and a heating, ventilation and air conditioning system for the 120-bed facility that provides nursing care in the City of St. Marys. On December 16, 2010 the Series 2002 Bond Issue was paid off and refinanced with the Series of 2010 in the amount of \$2,345,000.00. As of December 31, 2015, the Authority has made all scheduled payments of interest on the bond issue.

The general credit of the County of Elk continues to be obligated through a Guaranty Agreement. The County guarantees the payments required to be made by the Elk Haven Nursing Home Association to the Elk County Industrial Development Authority under a mortgage agreement to fund any cash flow deficits that may occur as a result of the Elk Haven Nursing Home renovation and the Silver Creek Terrace construction. Under the Guaranty agreement, the County must advance amounts equal to any delinquencies in the mortgage payments, if any should occur. This is a debt within the meaning of the Local Government Unit Debt Act. The bonds have been deemed to be self-liquidating as the Elk Haven Nursing Home Association continues to make its payments on the mortgage in favor of the Elk County Industrial Development Authority. No decrease in the amounts to be excluded is required by any change of circumstances other than decreases resulting from the payment of the bonds.

Our findings and recommendations have been communicated either orally or in writing on an individual departmental basis rather than being formally disclosed in the Auditors' Settlement Booklet, unless otherwise noted below.

Changes in the 2015 settlement include the addition of one new account, Solid Waste Authority Recycling Building Fund. County Wide Zoning and Technical Rescue were closed in 2014 causing their elimination from the current audit.

The Sheriff's Department has had some areas of concern in the past. The newly-elected Sheriff and his staff have been most cooperative with the Auditors in working on issues that needed addressed.

We look forward to a continued team effort working with all departments in 2016.
